Many members of the Wayland High School Class of 2019 are awaiting their college acceptance letters and they are also beginning to make decisions about how they will afford to finance the exorbitant costs of pursuing higher education. The mission of the Wayland High School Scholarship Committee is to solicit donations in order to award scholarships to those Wayland High School students in need. Thanks to the extraordinary generosity of individuals, families and businesses in our community, the Committee can award scholarships to many of those seniors who have financial need and show academic promise. Last spring our program was able to award \$85,000 to 26 deserving graduating seniors. We are so fortunate with your assistance to be able to grant these awards and we are here once again to ask for your generous support so we may continue in this effort.

Each spring the **Quarter Century Service Awards** are given out to honor those individuals who are retiring from the Wayland School System after 25 years or more of service. Although this year there are no retirees with 25 years of service, we will grant this scholarship award to a member of the class of 2019 so we may continue to extend our gratitude for all previous honorees who have been committed to enriching the lives of Wayland students, and for all of their contributions to the excellence of our schools.

This year we have added a new fund in honor of Coach Rick Moyer. "The Coach Rick Moyer - Great Life Experience Scholarship Award." Coach Moyer was a member of the staff at WHS for 30 years in the guidance department and as the Athletic Director, retiring in 1997. The award has been established by a very generous, anonymous donor and will be given to a student athlete who has demonstrated the qualities that Coach Moyer brought to the athletes and their families in Wayland, such as commitment to the sport, respect of teammates, dedication to studies and an appreciation for the strong foundation that their experience at Wayland High School has given them.
